Activity-1

- I feel
- **Catch a smile/a frown/a tear:** Play a game with the child where she/he can express her/his feelings and relate them to expressions. The parents can act out an expression and the child has to guess that and talk about how it makes her/him feel.
 - \rightarrow E.g. Catch a smile and tell me are you happy/sad/scared/angry?
 - → Catch a tear and tell me are you happy/sad/scared/angry?

Activity-2

- The Weather
- Help the child become familiar with different weather conditions, such as, sunny, windy, cloudy, foggy, rainy etc. Encourage the child to describe the weather using these terms. You could build a story starting with the weather, 'On a hot sunny day'. You can show the child the weather telecasts on the television and ask her/him to use symbols to mark the weather of that day, on the calendar.

Some of the symbols that the children can use are:



Activity-3

- Our Natural World
- Plant a tree with your child and nurture it together. Give your child empty egg cartons with small amounts of potting soil in the sections. Help them to plant different seeds, such as, coriander, peas etc. in the different sections and observe the mini nursery.

Self-discipline and good behaviour need to become an essential part of your child's routine. Set few basic rules. Both parents and grandparents must insist on them being followed as children feel confused when adults set different rules.

COGNITIVE ACTIVITY

- Oral counting: 0 to 200
- Practice of forward counting: 1 to 30 with the concept of Ones & Tens.
- Practice of number names 1 to 4 at home.

Activity 1: The days of the week: Put up a calendar in the room and ask the child to mark the day of the week every morning/evening till she/he mastered the order.

You can point to a day and ask the child the days that come before and after it. Encourage the use of today, tomorrow, yesterday etc.

Activity 2: Take a pack of card and place them face down. You can play memory with them. Each player is allowed to pick two cards. The first card is shown to all the other players, while the second card is only seen by the one whose turn it is. The idea is to make as many pairs of cards as possible.

Activity 3: Take some coins and make him/her count the money. Sort the rupee 5, 2 and 1 coins and make small piles. Each pile can be added.
